### Proposal for a liaison A between ETSI TC ITS and ISO TC 204

#### **Introduction:**

**ETSI TC ITS** and **ISO TC204** (Intelligent Transport Systems) have the common objective to perform and promote, directly or indirectly, regional and international standardization with the aim of contributing to the establishment and development of Intelligent Transport Systems. Both parties recognise the competence and expertise of each other in their respective areas of expertise, and both recognise that some of these may overlap or have complementary benefit.

#### **Objectives:**

**ETSI TC ITS** and **ISO TC204** have a reciprocal interest in avoiding duplication of technical work and have noted the benefits of structuring and strengthening their relationship in the Intelligent Transport Systems Sector. They therefore wish to

- adopt a complementary approach to the standardization process in the domains of mutual interest
- use complementary expertise to accelerate the establishment of Standardisation deliverables
- foster closer co-operation
- share mutual development
- have complementary Standards.

#### **Proposed actions:**

Create an official liaison between ETSI TC ITS and ISO TC 204. The formal TC ITS contact would be the Vice Chairman (**Robert Williams, CSI**) and he would be representing the views of the members of TC ITS. It is proposed that **liaison category A** is established.
